<b>PRONOMBRES POSESIVOS</b>	
Los pronombres posesivos sustituyen al sustantivo, los usamos para establecer una relación de posesión, concuerdan en género y número con la cosa poseída y nunca van delante del sustantivo.	
<b>POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS</b>	
<b>I</b>	That bicycle is <b>MINE</b> ..... esa bicicleta es <b>MÍA</b> ( Mine solo se usa para I )
<b>YOU</b>	That bicycle is <b>YOURS</b> ..... esa bicicleta es <b>TUYA</b> ( Yours solo se usa para YOU)
<b>HE</b>	That bicycle is <b>HIS</b> ..... esa Bicicleta es <b>SUYA</b> ( His solo se usa para HE)
<b>SHE</b>	That bicycle is <b>HERS</b> ..... esa Bicicleta es <b>SUYA</b> ( Hers se usa solo para SHE)
<b>IT</b>	-
<b>WE</b>	That bicycle is <b>OURS</b> ..... esa Bicicleta es <b>NUESTRA</b> ( Ours se usa solo para WE)
<b>THEY</b>	That bicycle is <b>THEIRS</b> ..... esa Bicicleta es <b>SUYA</b> ( Theirs se usa solo para THEY)
