**SHOULD & SHOULDN'T**

Una de las formas más utilizadas en inglés para dar consejos, es a través de los verbos modales SHOULD OR SHOULDN'T. En español, significa *deberías* y *no deberías*, respectivamente.

<b>Negative</b>	I shouldn't ... You shouldn't ... He shouldn't ...	I <u>shouldn't</u> go to bed late. You <u>shouldn't</u> eat chocolate. He <u>shouldn't</u> drink coffee.	Yo no debería ir a dormir tarde. Tú no deberías comer chocolate. Él no debería tomar café.
